



Developed to help banks assess their efforts to mitigate risks associated with ransomware and identify gaps for increasing security, the Ransomware Self-Assessment Tool (R-SAT) has now been updated to better protect against today's online environment. The R-SAT has 16 questions and is based on the BECTF Best Practices for Banks: Reducing the Risk of Ransomware.

Using this tool could assist any third parties that might review your security practices and provide your bank's executive management and Board of Directors with a better understanding of your bank's preparedness towards identifying, protecting, detecting, responding, and recovering from a ransomware attack.
